Early warning and response system

The Network for the Surveillance and Control of Communicable Diseases has been established by the European Parliament and Council Decision 2010/2002. The aim of the Network is to provide coordination and collaboration between the Member States, on the initiative of the European Commission, with a view to improving the prevention and control of communicable diseases. The Network consists of Early Warning and Response System (EWRS), which is intended to improve the communication with the public, through appropriate media, the Commission and the competent public health authorities in each Member State responsible for addressing the response which they are required to provide under the Directive.

The central location of the application is located on the website of the ECDC. The user interface contains links to sites containing health information and news which may be of interest to the public.

Access to this section is limited to the members of the ECDC, i.e. the competent Public Health Authorities of the EU Member States, which have been designated primarily by the Government of their Country as members of the ECDC, and the competent services of the European Commission.
